ELM CREEK WATERSHED MANAGEMENT COMMISSION

FEE SCHEDULE

- I. No applications will be reviewed until the Commission receives a complete application (all appropriate materials and fees).
- II. Member communities and other government agencies shall not pay fees for plan reviews, except for wetland alteration fees.

PROJECT FEES

- A. There is a Minimum Fee of \$300 for a plan review if the project involves floodplains or DNR shorelands.
- B. **Grading, Erosion Control and Stormwater Management Plan Review**
1. **Residential development with less than or equal to one unit /acre**
 2.0 - 8.0 acres \$500
 plus \$250/each five acres or fraction thereof not to exceed \$2,000
 2. **Residential development with more than one unit /acre**
 1.0 - 5.0 acres \$600
 plus \$300/each five acres or fraction thereof not to exceed \$5,000
 3. **All Other Development**
 first 1.0 acre or fraction thereof \$600
 each addl. acre or fraction thereof \$300 not to exceed \$10,000
- C. **Developments with mapped floodplains on site**
1. Impacts less than or equal to 100 cubic yards
 (including no impact) \$100
 2. Impacts greater than 100 cubic yards \$500
- D. **Drainage alterations**
 Any culvert installation or replacement, bridge construction, stream cross-section alteration, or any activity requiring a DNR Waters Permit,
 on Elm, Rush, North Fork Rush, or Diamond Creeks \$500
 on all other tributaries within the watershed \$100
- E. **Water appropriation permits (currently, two years)..... \$10**

WETLAND PROJECT FEES

- F. Wetland fees apply in the communities (Champlin, Corcoran and Hassan Township) where the Commission is the LGU for the Wetland Conservation Act (WCA) and are in addition to the project fees in the first column.
1. **Exemption certificates \$50**
 2. **Wetland replacement plans**
 <10,000 SF impact on single basins, or <1/4 acre impact
 for private driveways \$400
 3. **All other replacement plans \$1,000**
 4. **Wetland banking plans** (No additional fee is required if the plan is submitted concurrently with a replacement plan.)
 - a. **Application if an add-on to an approved replacement plan of less than 1,000 SF \$100**
 - b. **All other wetland banking applications \$1,000**
 5. **Determinations \$50**
 6. **Delineation review fee \$250**
- There may be additional wetland replacement plan and banking application escrows and sureties, which will be determined on a site-specific basis (see reverse side).*
- G. **Failure to make application and receive approval prior to beginning work 2X Fees**

Escrow and Surety Requirements

for Wetland Projects

Cash Escrows

Monitoring

Minimum \$6000/basin, to be determined on a site-specific basis, to cover Commission expenses related to the monitoring requirements of the Wetland Conservation Act (WCA). The balance in the escrow account will be refunded without interest following final completion of the project.

Extraordinary Expenses

Initial deposit of \$1,000, with additional deposits in \$1,000 increments will be required if expended. Extraordinary expenses will be billed based on actual costs incurred and deducted from the escrow. This escrow is required to cover Commission expenses for technical evaluation panels (TEPs), additional administrative, technical or legal processing costs (in excess of the \$1000 fee) associated with projects involving wetlands. The balance in the escrow account will be refunded without interest following final completion of the project.

Replacement Surety

To be determined on a site-specific basis, based on estimated costs to purchase replacement credits. This surety may also be used for expenses to conduct repair work on replacement wetlands. The surety may be submitted as a cash escrow, surety bond, or irrevocable letter of credit. This surety will be released when the Commission has determined that the replacement wetland meets all the requirements of WCA.

Financial guarantees shall be issued from financial institutions (banks, savings and loans and credit unions) having business offices within the greater Twin Cities metropolitan area. Financial guarantees, other than cash escrows, from individuals or corporations will not be accepted. The guarantee shall be for a period of five (5) years. All instruments submitted as financial guarantees of completion of required projects shall be submitted on a form provided by or approved by the Commission.

Effective January 1, 2003
